Qualifications: 1-5 years of successful fundraising activities and experience with challenge appeals, major donor events, strategies to maintain and broaden donor engagement; social media campaigns and development plans. Experience with grant writing and/or identification of grants and other opportunities in support of agency mission and goals. Communication strategies, donor/communication database management. Familiarity with Bloomerang desirable, not required.

Additional skills required include: Excellent written and verbal communication skills; computer skills in word processing, financial reporting and presentations; interpersonal skills supportive of relationship building with donors, volunteers and staff.

The Development Manager/Grant Writer is a contract position of a minimum of 20 hours/week. Compensation is based on experience.
